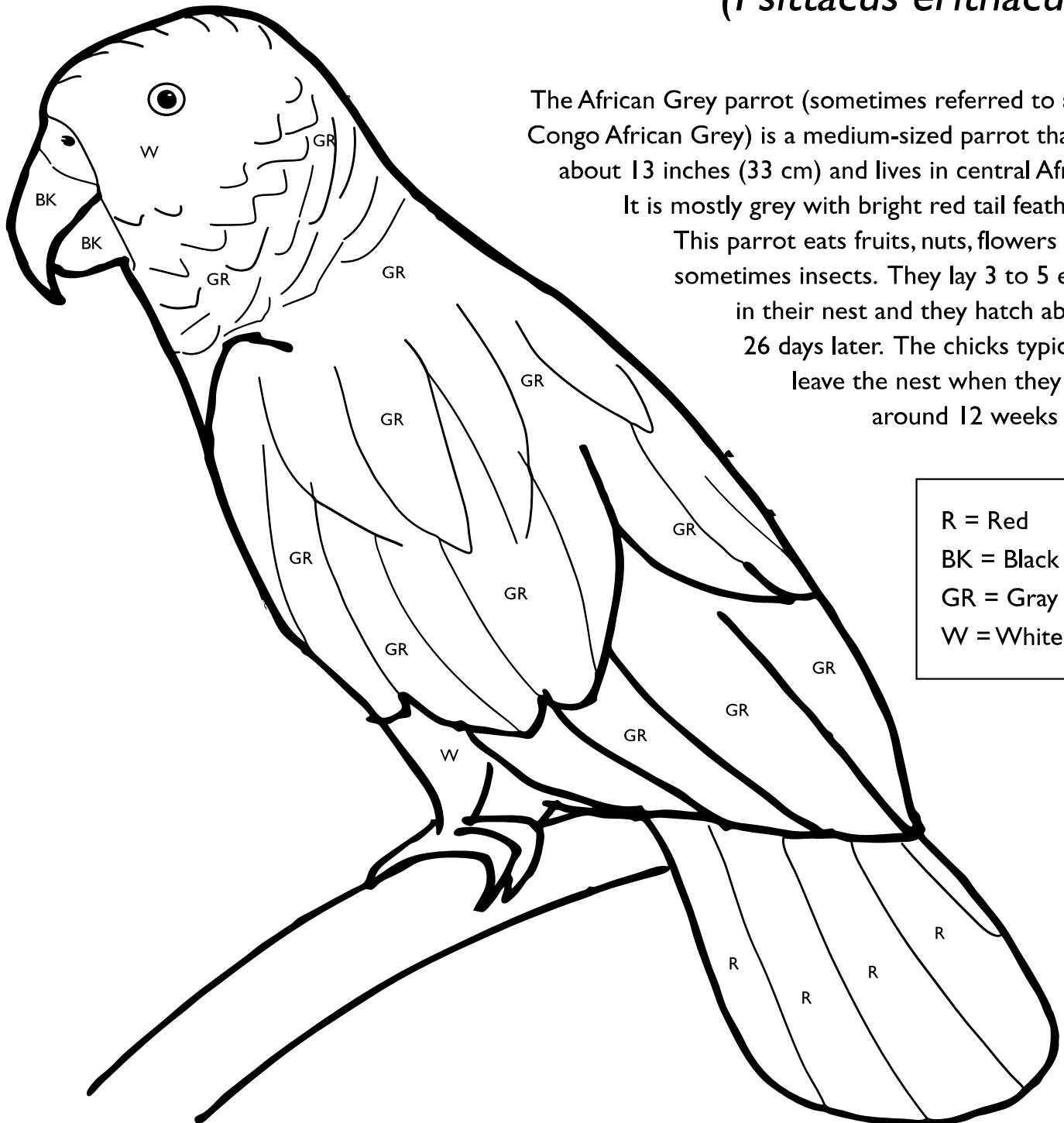


AFRICAN GREY

(*Psittacus erithacus*)



The African Grey parrot (sometimes referred to as a Congo African Grey) is a medium-sized parrot that is about 13 inches (33 cm) and lives in central Africa.

It is mostly grey with bright red tail feathers.

This parrot eats fruits, nuts, flowers and sometimes insects. They lay 3 to 5 eggs in their nest and they hatch about 26 days later. The chicks typically leave the nest when they are around 12 weeks old.
