

GOLDEN CONURE

(*Guaruba guarouba*)

The Golden conure is a medium-sized parrot from the Amazon rainforest in Brazil. It is approximately 13 inches (34 cm) long and mostly yellow with the exception of its green wing feathers. They eat seeds, nuts, fruits, flowers, and buds. Though a pair mate and lay eggs, other Golden conures help with raising the chicks. They lay up to 6 eggs that take about 22-26 days to hatch in hollow nests high up in the trees.
