

SULPHUR- CRESTED COCKATOO

(*Cacatua galerita*)



These larger cockatoos call Australia and Indonesia home and can range in size. They can run from 17 inches up to around 22 inches (44-55 cm) with the larger birds living in Australia. They are mostly white, with a yellow crest and light yellow feathers under the wings and tail. They forage in trees and on the ground searching for seeds, nuts, and fruits. They lay 2 to 3 eggs in a tree hollow which take 25 to 27 days to hatch. The young may stay in the nest up to 12 weeks and these chicks may continue to stay with the parents for several months.
